Grade Average: Students must complete at least 60 applicable semester units with a grade point average of at least a 2.0.

Major Requirements For an A.A. degree, students must complete at least 18 units in one discipline as listed in the Napa Valley College catalog. For an A.S. degree, the requirement is usually 30 or more semester units in the major, as listed in the Napa Valley College catalog. Along with major course requirements, all students pursuing an A.A./A.S. degree must also complete general education course requirements for graduation.

GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS for A.A. or A.S. degrees Met Need
