

Multicultural/ Ethnic Studies Articulation Status For CSU and UC Requirements

Most CSU and UC campuses have a Breadth or Graduation requirement in Multicultural, Diversity, Race, or Ethnicity. This requirement varies from campus to campus. For many campuses, which include CSU Fresno, San Francisco State University and San Jose State University, this requirement may only be completed by taking an upper division course. For several campuses, though, students may take a course at a community college to fulfill this requirement.
